General Information

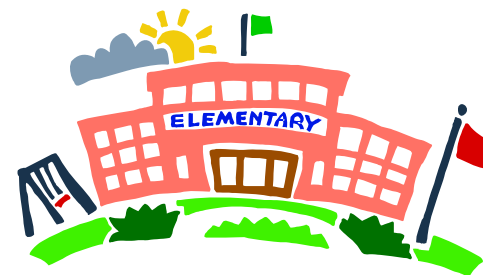
Registration: Please completely fill out both sides of the registration form and submit with the non-refundable fee per class to SFA School Summer Scholars, 2100 N. Germantown Parkway, Cordova, TN 38016.

Admission: Class sizes are limited. Admission is granted to students in the order in which the registration form and payment are received. Registration is ongoing until the first day of class. A \$25 discount applies to registrations received prior to May 25th.

Dress: T-Shirts, shorts, socks and sneakers are just right. Sandals, flip flops or slippers are allowed, too. Bring a sweatshirt or sweater for those cooler than usual air conditioned rooms.

Before & After: If students are registered in the Camp Timberwolf Extended Care program, they will be escorted to and from class each day.

For those students not in the Extended Care summer program, please be sure to drop off and pick up your child **ON TIME**. Personnel is not available for adequate supervision before and after class.



MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH REFRESHER STUDENTS ENTERING GRADES 6, 7 & 8

Cost: \$225

Non Refundable \$100 Registration fee due May 25th
Balance due on or before the first day of class.

Instruction will be tailored to the grade level requirements in 6th, 7th and 8th grades and will help students master pre-requisites for attaining success. Students will review problem solving, operations with integers, percent proportion, basic geometry, and measures of central tendency. Students will cover the material that will be introduced the first nine weeks of class study. Students will take a pre-test and post-test to measure mastery of core skills.

ALEKS SUMMER COURSE STUDENTS ENTERING GRADES 5-8

Cost: \$200

Two instructors will be on site offering hands-on assistance for students as they meet the required 15 Summer hours of ALEKS. Students who attend all 14 days of ALEKS lab will not only exceed their summer requirements, but benefit from one-on-one assistance for skills students may be struggling with.
