CBHS Summer Soccer Camp

- Boys and girls ages 5-14 grouped by age and skill level.
- Skill levels range from beginner to advanced.
- The focus is on player development with special emphasis on technique and skill.
- Coaching is geared toward both individual and team development.

Daily Schedule:

9:00 - 10:15 Technical Session
10:15 - 10:30 Break / Contest
10:30 - 12:00 Games

Goalkeepers: There will be specialized sessions for goalkeepers each day covering angle play, technique, distribution and footwork.

Cost:

\$100 for the entire week per camper. Each additional brother or sister signing up pays only \$90 per camper.

Reimbursements

A \$50 reimbursement fee will be given if camper becomes sick (with a doctor's note) prior to the camp date, or if a camper decides not to attend prior to the camp date.

- Camp is cancelled due to poor weather conditions
 - Camper is absent without excuse on the first two days
 - Camper becomes sick during the week of camp
- *** Camp Date Change: Prior arrangements must be made with camp director Rogério Lima. There will be no charge to change camp dates if space is available.

Camp Location: CBHS- Walnut Grove Rd. & I-240 - 3 soccer fields located behind CBHS.

Pick Up & Drop Off

Soccer fields are located **behind** CBHS, accessible via Humphreys.

From Shelby Farms: Turn right onto Humphreys, the soccer field entrance is at the end of the road on the left. (avoid parking in front of Baptist office building entrance)

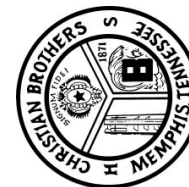
