2. RE-REGISTRATION OF CURRENT STUDENTS

Tuition statements were emailed January 13th. It was the last quarterly statement for the current school year and tuition payments are due by February 1. Re-registration packets will be sent home or mailed on February 6. The re-registration card and \$250 re-registration fee will be due February 15, to secure your child’s seat for the 2012-2013 school year. Those families with past due tuition will not be allowed to re-register their child(ren) therefore, not securing their seat for the next school year. Open enrollment for new applicants will be offered February 16. Please make sure to secure your child’s seat by having all tuition paid by February 1st, to allow the re-registration process to be completed by February 15th.
